The Church at Clam Gulch has been meeting for 5 years now! We started with 3 (one family) and now have 25 or more attending regularly. We continue to meet by having a shared meal, then the Service, then dessert, all of which builds great fellowship time. As of August 26th we have had 2 baptisms.

Currently we meet at other locations with a goal to complete the church building, which was started last year, by 2019! We received our Alaska State Fire Marshall permit allowing us to work toward completion on electrical and mechanical requirements. A good well has been drilled and the plan is to complete the septic in September. We are working out of pocket, without a loan, and we trust God for His provision. We see God's hand in many ways. This is truly a work of faith! We are convinced that God wants a church in Clam Gulch and we move ahead. Most of our members are retired and we are not a rich congregation. Yet, we continue to have money in our building fund. We have had great volunteer help from outside the church and from our members. We are thankful for everything that comes our way, gifts, discounts, donations, and help, knowing that God has a hand in it! The preacher, Charles Stanley, has an appropriate saying: "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and leave the consequences to Him."

We would ask of you, to remember the Church at Clam Gulch, that God would bless our efforts and that we will be a beacon of Light and Truth to our community. 
